I also understand that if I do not earn a C grade or higher on the proficiency exam, I may subsequently elect to try options (1) or (3).

\_\_\_\_\_ (3) I will take a PH2100 proficiency exam, arranged through the physics department. I understand that I must earn a grade of C or higher on the exam to earn departmental placement credit for PH2100. I understand that if I do not earn a C or higher grade on the PH2100 proficiency exam I will need to take PH2100 to earn credit for it. [Students who satisfactorily complete this option may subsequently earn credit for PH2200 by either trying option (2), or by taking and passing the class.]
