**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM (2013)**

**Purpose:** The John Wesley-James Jones Memorial Foundation was established to assist Christian students enrolled at Michigan Technological University (MTU) and Finlandia University who continue actively to pursue their Christian faith while attending college.

**Eligibility:** Full-time undergraduate students enrolled at Michigan Technological University or Finlandia University who will have sophomore or higher status by the fall of 2013 are eligible to apply for Wesley-Jones Foundation scholarships. Applicants must be active in a local Church and be active in Christian activities and/or organizations on campus.

**Scholarship Amounts and Award Schedule:** Typically the Foundation awards 8-12 scholarships varying from **\$1000 to \$3000 per academic year**, conditional on proof of enrollment. Half the value of the scholarship is delivered to each student's account at the appropriate school near the beginning of the fall and the spring semester.

**Renewal:** Scholarships are not automatically renewed. However, prior awardees may reapply.

**Please Attach or Arrange for the Foundation to Receive the Following**

1.  **Official transcript** of all college classes taken up to the date of the application.
2.  **Two letters of reference** *discussing your involvement in Christian activities.*  
One of these letters **must** be provided by a leader in a local Christian group with which you have been involved while at Michigan Tech (pastor, priest, college program coordinator, director, etc.). We prefer that one of the two letters be from the pastor or campus ministry coordinator of the local church with which you have been involved, but that is not absolutely necessary. If you wish, one of the letters *may be* from the pastor, priest, or youth director of your pre-MTU/Finlandia home church discussing your involvement in Christian activities while a member there. (Letters of reference can be collected and provided by the applicant if the writer has placed the letter in a sealed envelope, or letters can be sent directly to Foundation at the address on the front of this application).
3.  **Personal statement** [typed, one-page *maximum*]. This should be **clearly** divided into **three distinct parts**: **(A)** a short, personal statement of faith/view on life; **(B)** an outline of your involvement in Christian activities and outreach while at college and in the past, and your plans for such activities and involvement during the coming year; and **(C)** a brief statement of your career goals.
4.  **Brief statement of basis of need** *on a separate sheet of paper.* This should indicate how you are funding your way through college. Need is a secondary rather than a primary criterion in the Foundation's decision making, but it is considered very seriously nonetheless.
